I understand that I must notify the school in writing of any changes in my child's condition, medication, or dosage. I further understand that I am responsible for ensuring that medication safely arrives at school and for getting refills of the medication as indicated.

A parent's or guardian's signature is required for prescription and non-prescription medication (aspirin, Tylenol, Advil, Sudafed, etc.).
